## WESTBANK ROCKER RULES

1. All AERC, PNER & ERABC rules apply.
2. The Veterinarian's opinion will be final in matters concerning the condition of the horse. Horses disqualified by the vets may not continue on.
3. Shoes or easy boots are highly recommended (although not mandatory) for those horses doing the 50 mile ride.
4. Rider consumption of alcohol during the ride is prohibited.
5. All horses must be presented at ALL vet checks before, during and after the ride. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.
6. All horses must pass post-ride completion criteria of 'Fit to Continue including Sound at the Trot' to earn completion.
7. Ride management or veterinarians will excuse unmanageable or unruly horses.
8. Stallions must be ridden by persons 18 years or older.
9. Horses entered in this event must be at least 60 months old at the time of the ride. This applies to the 50 mile ride only.
10. The same horse and rider must follow the prescribed course, do multiple loops in correct order, pass all check points on the same marked trail together, and finish within the prescribed time.
11. No horse may be paced or prompted by an unentered, withdrawn or otherwise unauthorized horse, vehicle or person other than the entrant.
12. The fastest horse to finish and meet the completion criteria of 'Fit to Continue including Sound at the Trot' is the winner. This applies to the 50 mile ride only. The 22 mile ride times are not finished until the heart rate meets criteria as per stated in the ERABC rules.
13. Riders under 16 years old as of December 1, 2006 must be accompanied by an adult sponsor, 21 years or older, during the entire ride. They must be within 1 minute of the sponsor at all times.
14. Protective headgear with harness is mandatory for all junior riders and strongly recommended for all riders.
15. Drugs of any kind are prohibited in horses participating in AERC sanctioned endurance rides. AERC Rule #13.
16. Abuse of horse; harassment of ride personnel, other riders or crews; removing or altering trail markers, or cheating will not be tolerated.
17. The horse may not have received or required medical treatment by veterinarian or layman prior to final veterinarian examination.
18. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH AND/OR CONFINED AT ALL TIMES!!

I agree to comply with all rules and regulations as set out by the American Endurance Riders Conference, Pacific Northwest Endurance Riders, Endurance Riders Assoc. of B.C. and ride management. I will accept all decisions made by veterinarians regarding the horse I am riding. I also understand that I am entering this ride at my own risk and assume full responsibility for my own and my horse's safety. I agree I will not hold ride management, ERABC, AERC, or PNER or their directors responsible for any accident or injury. I further agree that I will not hold any landowner responsible for any accident or injury. I have read fully the documents attached to this form and agree to the above.
