RIDE OVER THE RAINBOW RULES

1. All Endurance Canada/Equine Canada rules apply. Copies available upon request.
2. The control judges' opinion will be final in all matters concerning the condition of the horse. Horses disqualified by the judges must not continue on.
3. All 100 mile horses must be shod all around. No 100 mile horse may leave any vet check with shoes missing. Hoof boots accepted. Shoes or hoof boots are highly recommended although not mandatory for 50 and 30 mile horses.
4. Rider consumption of alcohol during the ride is prohibited.
5. All horses must be presented to ALL vet checks before, during, and after the ride. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
6. All horses must pass post-ride completion criteria of "Fit to Continue" at 30 mins after finishing to earn completion.
7. Ride management or control judges will excuse unmanageable or unruly horses.
8. Stallions must be ridden by persons 18 years or older.
9. Horses entered in the 30 mile ride must be a minimum of 48 months old. Horses entered in the 50 and 100 mile rides must be a minimum of 60 months old.
10. The same horse and rider must follow the prescribed course, do multiple loops in correct order, pass all check points on the same marked trail together, and finish within the prescribed time,
11. No horse may be prompted or paced by an unentered, withdrawn, or otherwise unauthorized horse, vehicle, or person other than the entrant.
12. The fastest horse to finish and meet the completion criteria is the winner in the 50 and 100 mile rides. The 30 mile ride time does not stop until the horse's heart rate meets criteria.
13. Riders under 16 years old as of December 1 2009 must be accompanied by an adult sponsor, 21 years or older, during the entire ride. They must be within 1 minute of the sponsor at all times.
14. Protective headgear with harness is mandatory for all junior riders and strongly recommended for all riders
15. Drugs of any kind are prohibited within 48 hours of competition.
16. Abuse of horse, harassment of ride personnel, other riders or crews, removing or altering trail markers, or cheating will not be tolerated.
17. The horse may not receive or require medical treatment by control judges or layman prior to final veterinary examination.
18. **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH OR CONFINED AT ALL TIMES!**

I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of Equine Canada at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless EC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives.
