Directions to Camp: From Osoyoos head south on Main Street, toward Hwy 3, continue on for about 52 km turn right off of Hwy 3 at ride signage and follow signs to Rock Creek Fairgrounds. From Kelowna follow Hwy 33 through Beaverdell head towards Rock Creek turning at Westbridge turn right at Hwy 33 to Hwy 3 turn left off of Hwy 3 and follow signs to Rock Creek Fairgrounds for further detailed directions refer to <http://maps.google.ca/?q=rock%20creek%20bc>

Fees: In Canadian Funds: 50 Miles - \$85.00 30 Mile - \$55.00 Fun Ride - \$40.00

Have your fees waived when you collect \$200.00 worth of pledges from your friends, boss, corporate sponsor etc. All pledges and completed form must be submitted at ride time to qualify. Proceeds will go towards KRTA trails development and maintenance & ERABC newly formed trails fund...

AERC Sanctioned Ride & AHA Recognized...participants must present current AERC & AHA card at ride or pay \$15.00 AERC fee where applicable (except for fun ride) \$10.00 AHA fee, Junior discount for 50 and 30 mile ride... NO discount for Fun Ride



Potluck Dinner scheduled at 6pm followed by award presentations at 7pm on ride day, the Gold Pan Restaurant is available throughout the weekend for folks who would like to enjoy Rock Creek's plentiful country cuisine...

General: Lots of open and treed drive-thru camping; there will be no problem with large rigs. Camp will be open on Friday, May 21st ~ lots of trails to ride. Coin operated showers (bring loonies). Horse & potable water available from Friday to Monday. Registration forms available through ERABC website www.erabc.com send before May 17th, 2010 and save \$25.00 on late registration fee, there will not be a cancellation fee for this ride so no reason

to not pre-register and save the late charge fee. See registration form for details...

Trails: Wonderful trails in spectacular country, good footing, great views. Steep to begin with from fairgrounds but well worth the climb. Discover the varied routes throughout the non-motorized registered trail system and the swimming hole in the Kettle River to the west side of the camp. Meet the friendly caretakers and take advantage of stabling as well as camping and showers at the fairgrounds.
